MONTANA'S ONLY WALKABLE BREWERY TRAIL is located in the heart of downtown Billings. This self-guided tour is made up of six breweries, two distilleries and one cider house, all within easy walking distance. Take this 1.5-mile brewery route and enjoy historic sites along the way.



Yellowstone Valley Brewing Co.

Your first stop is a brewery and distillery in one, with open mic nights and live music often. Enjoy a handcrafted Yellowstone brew-Grizzly Wulf Wheat, Wild Fly Ale, Renegade Red Ale, Huckleweizen and Black Widow Oatmeal Stout. Or, enjoy homemade vodka and gin in their distillery tasting room.

Last Chance Pub & Cider Mill
